NAME OF THE COURSE:

General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM). 3 -½ yrs course.

ACCREDITATION

The G.N.M Programme is fully accredited by the Indian Nursing Council (January 2006). The Nursing Training School is under the affiliation of the West Bengal Nursing Council with effect from January 2006. Number of candidate to be admitted per year is 30 (subject to change as per INC & WBNC recommendation).

ELIGIBILITY: Candidate for admission course will be required to have:

1. **Qualification:** 10+2 or Higher secondary passed / or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks (Science stream preferable).
NO VOCATIONAL MARKS WILL BE ENTERTAINED
2. **Age:** Completed the age of 18 years on 31st December 2006. And not more than 35 years on 31st December of year 2006. (Age proof – Admit card of Secondary or Madhyamik Examination).
3. **Marital status:** Unmarried/Divorcee/Widows (authentic document to be submitted).
4. Must be able to read, write, and Speak in English. (As Course is in English).
5. **Residentiality:** Candidate must be resident of west Bengal un-interruptedly for last 5 years.

(Residential Certificate to be submitted which the local MLA/ MP/ Counsellor/ Sabhadhipati/ Sabhapati/ D.M/BDO).

1. Duly attested Xerox copies (2) of the mark sheet of H.S (10+2) / or equivalent examination.
2. Duly attested Xerox copies (2) of the admit card of Secondary / Madhyamik Exam.
3. Passport size photo (4) duly attested to be submitted.
4. Residential Certificate (Original)
5. Character Certificate from last school or college (Original)
6. Any document of extra curricular activities.
